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Burst out in color this Spring by indulging in cool tones of blue and lilac colored eyes. This Spring calls for pastels colors and nudes. Pink or peach candy colored lips and soft flushed cheeks. This is a great look for light to fair complexions. Your eyes are the main attraction. Try using a sunset orange on the inner corner of eyes and light pink on the outer corner. Add a touch of baby blue to the lower lid and line your eyes in white to make them pop and look alive. For darker completions, color is great when considering the contrast.

If you have an Olive complexion, it will radiate confidently in shades of mauve. Soft reds and cream colored shades suit you best. For a natural look sweep a bronzing blush or blush highlighter to your apples. For a softer look apply a muted pink rose gloss to complete this look. If you're bold, pump up the volume by adding a bright red to your lips and keep the rest to a minimum

Smoky or cat shaped eyes look great for a night out on the town: Create a fierce, smoldering gaze by smudging a medium toned grey liner around eyes. Then add lilac or purple around both your upper and lower eye lids. Blend the two colors until you have achieved a smoky look and then add lots of mascara. The grey will seamlessly blend into the purple, giving you that added glamour for the night. Keep your pout nude or add shine with a gloss.

To look hot during the day and night pick out makeup formulas that contain bronzers and shimmer to restore your warm weather glow. Try something different, like a blast of shimmering orange instead of your traditional red. The hottest colors for the season are orange, gold and green!
